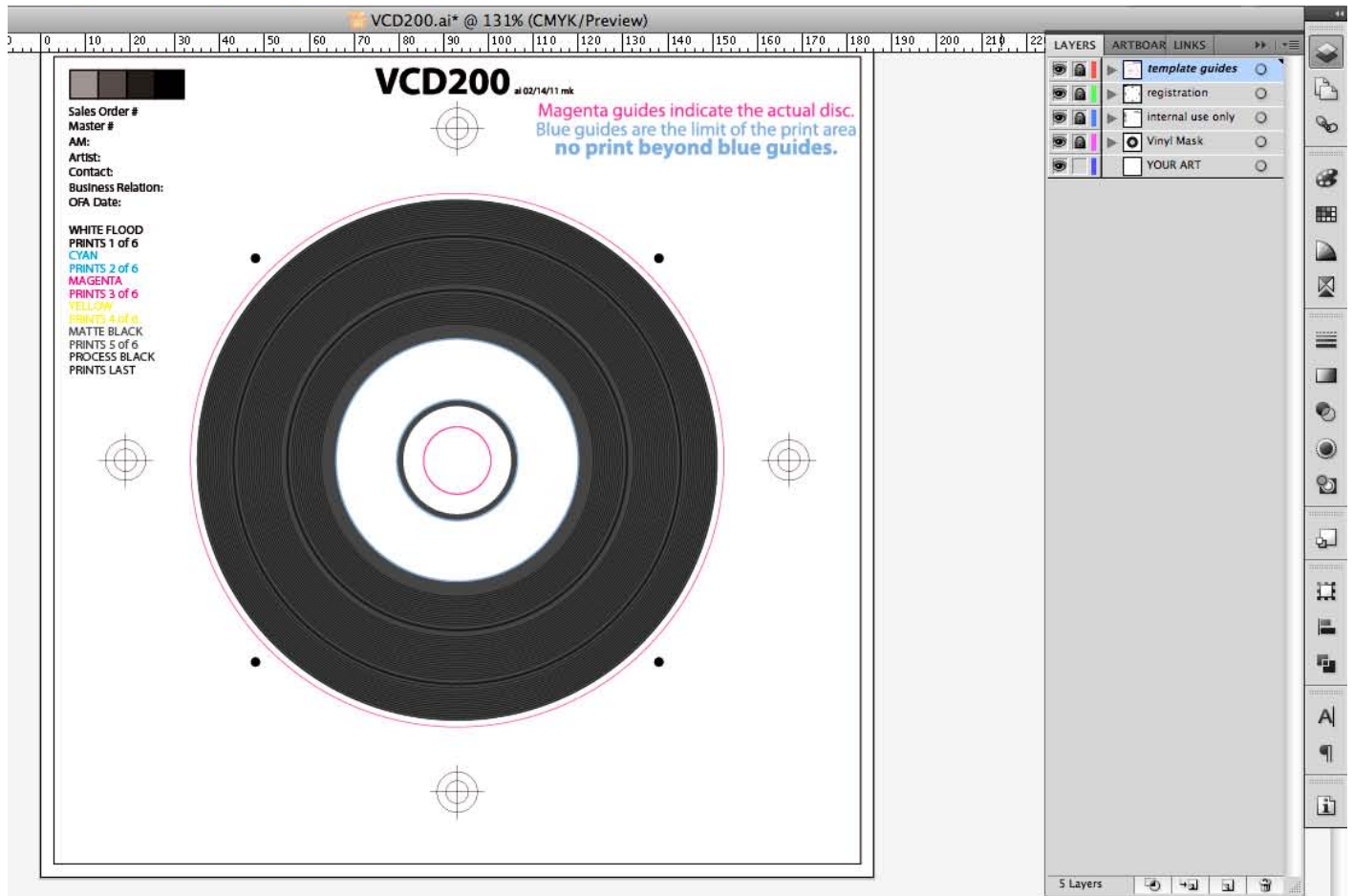


How to use the VCD200 template



When you open the template for the first time you will see the simulated vinyl rings and a white ring where your label will print.



Please note that the only unlocked layer is labeled **YOUR ART**.

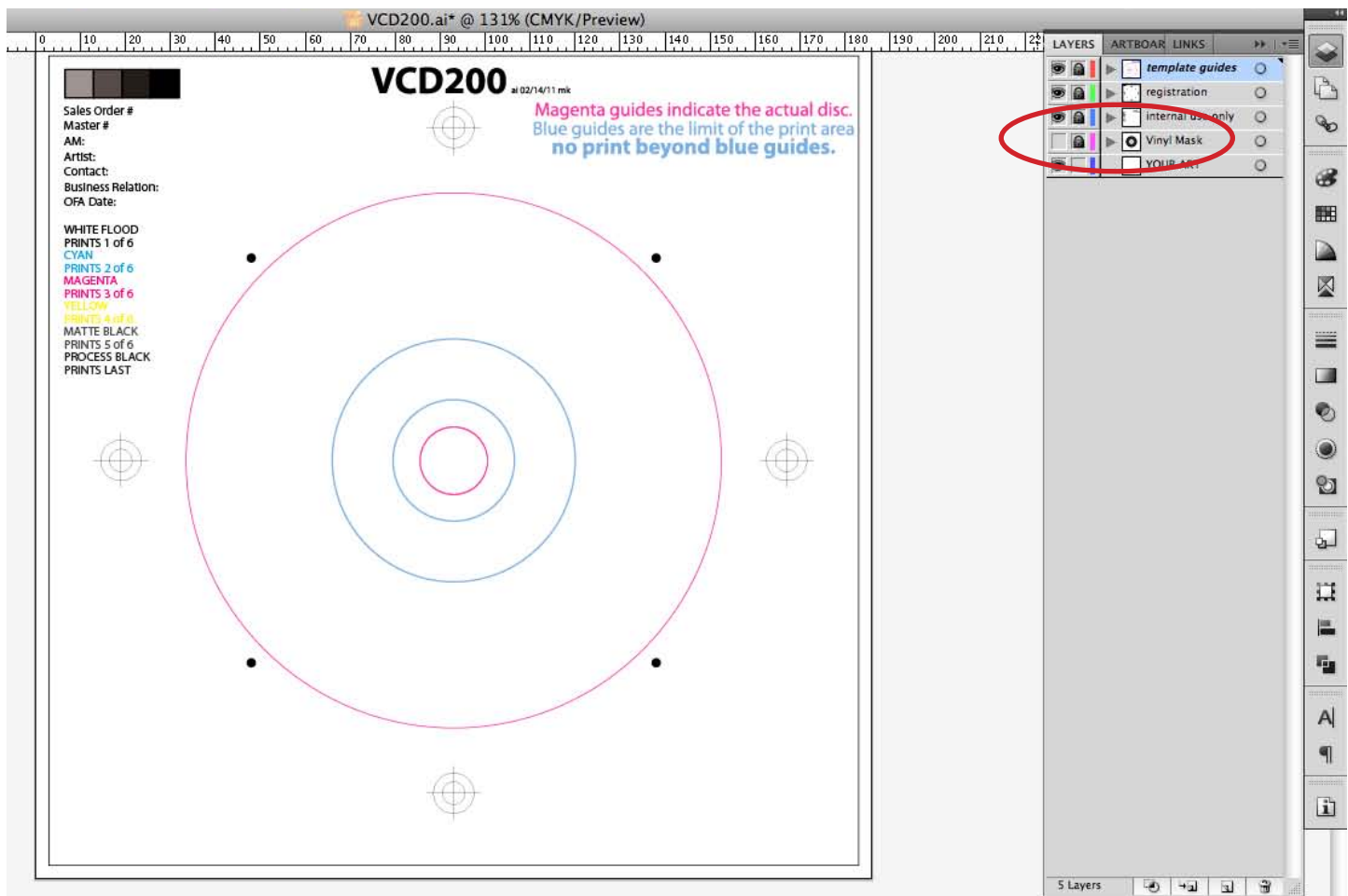
Use this layer to create your design.

You can add layers but they must stay below the four locked layers.



Click the eye symbol to the left of the Vinyl Mask layer to hide the mask and show only the template guides.

Clicking the eye again will turn the mask back on so you can see how your design will look as is shown on page 5.

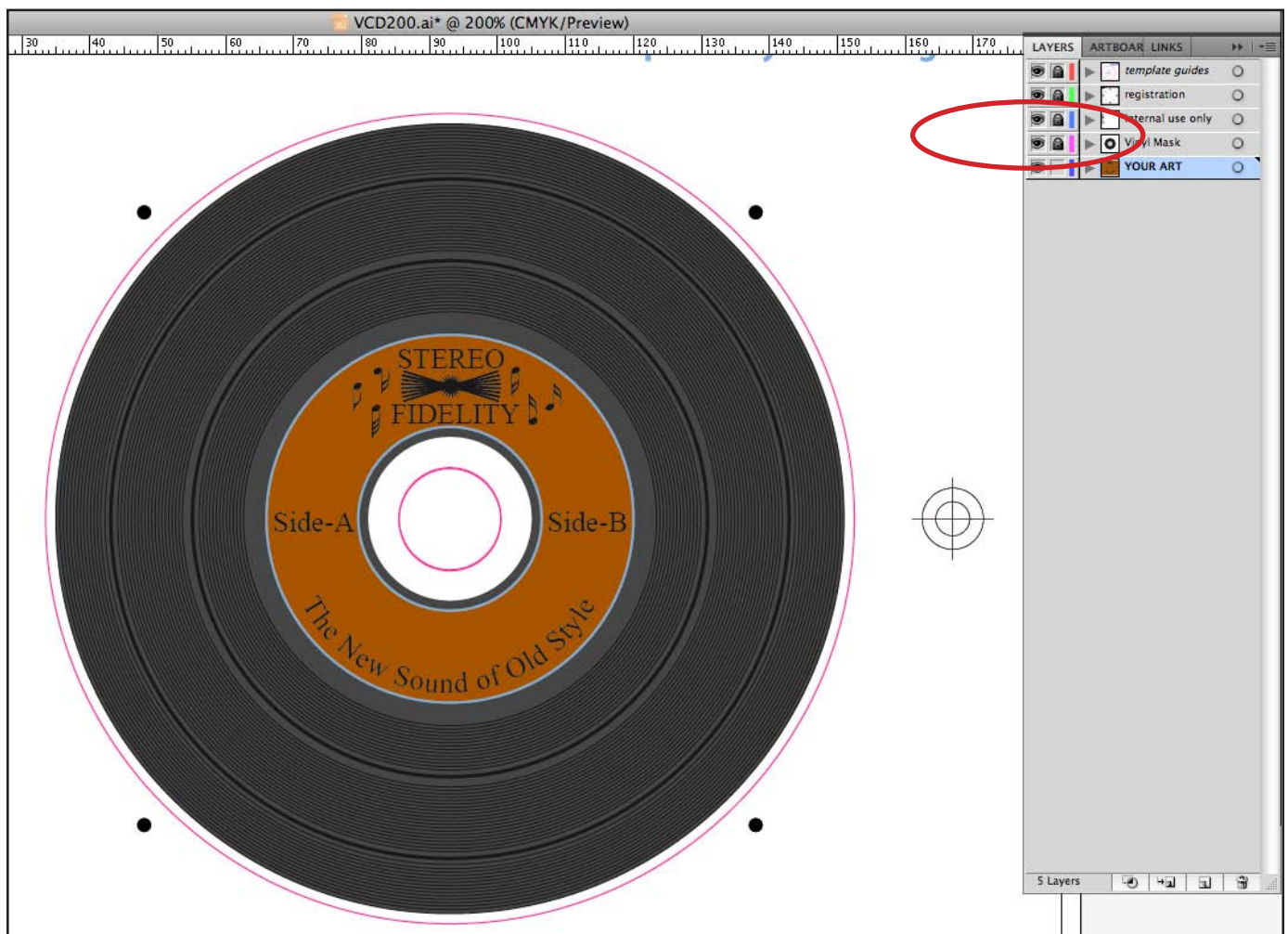


With the Vinyl Mask layer off you can easily see the blue guides indicating where your label will print.

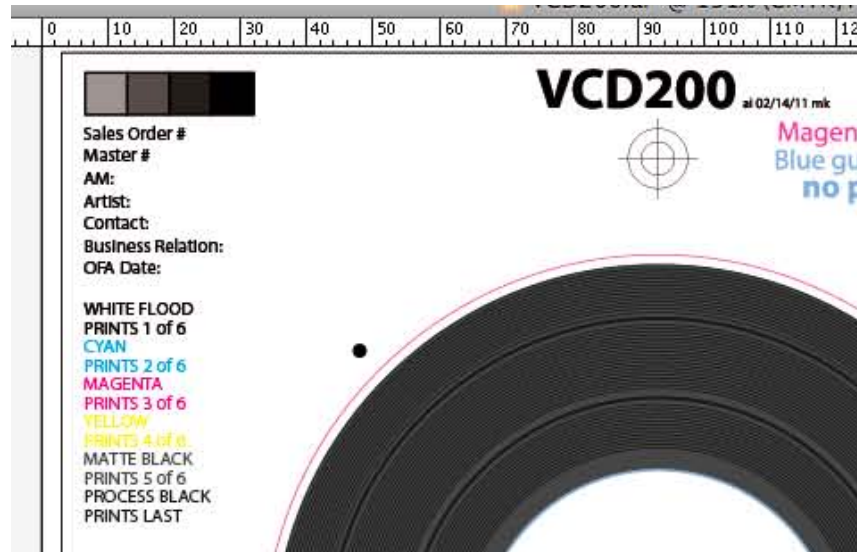
Be certain that your background extends beyond the outer guide and all text and art stays between the blue guides.



Switching the Vinyl Mask layer on and off is a quick and easy way to keep an eye on how your design is looking.



The template comes with the color list defined for full color CMYK printing. If you are designing with spot colors you can use up to 3 separate spot colors and black. The white flood and matte black inks are required for the vinyl look and may not be substituted.



Save your file in the same version of the software that you are using. Please do not flatten your file or save in an older version.
